We are recruiting fully-licenced Ontario drivers living in Ottawa and aged 55 or older.

Volunteers will participate in a research study that is taking place **from July through to September 2015**. The objective of the study is to design a new road test.

This study is being conducted by the **Traffic Injury Research Foundation (TIRF)** in Ottawa with the goal of making roads safer for all Canadians. Participation is confidential and data that are collected will be used only by the research team for the purposes of this study to protect the privacy of participants.

As a volunteer in this study, you would be asked to participate in:

- > A consent procedure to fully explain to you the purpose and process of the study as well as your rights and privacy protections as a participant;
- > A screening test to see if you are eligible to participate;
- > A road test;
- > An exit-survey to ask about your experiences during this road test.

Participation in the study will not affect your licensing status in any way!

It will take approximately **two hours** to participate in this study.

If you meet eligibility criteria to participate and you complete the road test and exit survey, you will receive **\$100** to compensate you for your time.
